Although classical music eventually won out, he still has the jazz bug somewhere inside him and it's desperate to come out. He's directed Supertonic since its inception in 2014 and when he's not being covertly filmed dancing in rehearsals in lieu of actually conducting, he teaches classroom music, brass teaching and takes even more choirs at Tawa College. He brings to the role his experience as a classically trained singer and singing teacher, and recently he sang the role of Pilate in Tudor Consort's performance of St Matthew Passion. He also sings in, and is an Associate Conductor with Voice New Zealand Chamber Choir. Of particular note is his success with the Tawa College chamber choir Blue Notes, which has been selected for the Big Sing Finale every year since 2014 and won a Gold award and the most recent two festivals.
